



## Smithfield & Isle of Wight, Virginia

### Two-day Group Itinerary

Nestled along the Pagan River, Smithfield and Isle of Wight County, Virginia is a quaint river-port town rich in Hams, History, Hospitality and HeART.

#### Day One:

- 9:00 a.m. Arrive at Visitor Center
- 9:30 a.m. Historic Downtown Walking Tour  
65+ Colonial, Federal and Victorian homes  
(Docent available to escort the group if requested)
- 11:00 a.m. Isle of Wight County Museum  
The “Ham Museum” celebrating our agricultural and Historical heritage
- 12:00 noon Lunch in the Historic District at one of our diverse eateries
- 1:30 p.m. Schoolhouse Museum  
Restored one-room 1924 African American schoolhouse
- 3:00 p.m. Browse the specialty shops and galleries of the Historic District especially the Smithfield Ice Cream Parlor and the Christmas Store
- 6:30 p.m. Put on your best clothes and dine in elegance at the historic Smithfield Inn (circa 1752) George Washington really *did* sleep here!

#### Day Two:

- 9:00 a.m. Historic Fort Huger  
Restored strategic Civil War fort in a beautiful setting overlooking the James River and the Ghost Fleet of the Atlantic
- 10:30 a.m. Historic St. Luke’s Shrine  
The oldest existing church of English foundation in America (circa 1632), with original 17th century altar fittings, stained glass and a cemetery once used as an encampment during the Civil War
- 12:00 noon Lunch in the Historic District at one of our diverse eateries
- 1:30 p.m. Boykin’s Tavern  
Restored tavern, originally built in 1762, played an important role in the history of Isle of Wight County and American history
- 3:00 p.m. Old Courthouse of 1750  
Originally modeled after the Capitol Building in Williamsburg
- 5:30 p.m. Dine waterside along the Pagan River at Smithfield Station Waterfront Inn & Marina

**Extend your stay** another day by arriving on Friday night and planning your visit around our monthly year-round SmARTs (Smithfield Monthly Arts Stroll) event, when downtown merchants stay open from 5:00 – 8:00 p.m. and feature visual and performing artists, refreshments and beverages.
